

POLICY EGAA –Copyright

The Board believes in the rights of creators and expects employees to be aware of and uphold these rights as required by the *Copyright Act*. The Board supports the use of duplicated materials and public performance of media materials only when copyright laws permit such activity.

The Board also believes that, unless there is an agreement to the contrary, the employer owns the copyright of works created by employees in the course and scope of their employment.

To establish guidelines for use of copyright materials.
