

POLICY IFCA – Student Dress & Hygiene

The board expects suitable dress for all school-related activities. Dress influences the attitudes of students toward themselves and their work.

PURPOSE:

To encourage a positive school climate through student dress and hygiene.

GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

- 1. Principals and teachers are encouraged to work with parents and students in the development of standards of dress and hygiene.
- 2. The criteria used should include standards which will promote:
 - a. cleanliness, neatness, and generally positive attitudes;
 - b. appropriateness for the particular activity, and
 - c. safety.
- 3. At the beginning of each school year, students are to be informed of the standards of dress and hygiene.
- 4. The Principal of the school (or designate) has the authority to request a student to correct a condition in dress or personal appearance that offends convention or attracts undue attention.
- 5. A student may be suspended from class (or school) for failing to conform until such time as he/she has complied with the principal's request.
- 6. In extenuating circumstances, the Superintendent may issue regulations and/or guidelines governing student dress and hygiene.
