

## POLICY IFCI – Drug and Alcohol Use by Students

The following will not be tolerated at school\*:

- consumption, use, possession or sale of alcohol, cannabis, illegal/restricted, controlled or non-prescribed drugs;
- possession or sale of drug paraphernalia;
- showing evidence of having recently consumed or used alcohol, cannabis illegal/restricted, controlled or non-prescribed drugs.

#### **PURPOSE**

To support the development and maintenance of a safe and secure learning environment for students and staff.

# **DEFINITION**

\* For the purpose of this policy, 'school' refers to the school, on school grounds, or buses, or school-related or school-sanctioned activities.

- A controlled substance is generally a drug or chemical whose manufacture, possession, or use is regulated by a government, such as illicitly used drugs or prescription medications that are designated a Controlled Drug in Canada.
- Paraphernalia miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for use of consumption of drugs:
- Cannabis- includes all forms or derivatives.
- Non-prescribed either a substances that is available without a prescription or a substance that was not prescribed for that individual.

### **GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES**

- 1. Selling or supplying alcohol, <u>cannabis</u>, <u>illegal/restricted</u>, <u>controlled or non-prescribed drugs</u> is a criminal offence. Employees shall advise the School Administrator of the name of any student suspected of these activities.
- 2. If a student is found in possession of alcohol, cannabis, illegal/restricted, controlled or nonprescribed drugs, or if a student is suspected of being under the influence, the School Administrator:
  - a) shall make reasonable attempts to contact the parent to remove the student from the school;
  - b) will take appropriate disciplinary action;
  - c) may refer the student to an appropriate support resource;
  - d) may report the incident to the police.
- 3. If a student is experiencing health concerns/overdose, the student shall be taken to a medical facility or medical assistance will be administered as outlined in <u>Policy IHCD</u> Administration of Medical Assistance to Students.
